-We will have marked lines in front of the building for line ups. Please respect the 6' distance at all times.

-If all the spaces in the lineup area are occupied kindly remain in your vehicle until a spot opens up. We ask that you be courteous to others and wait your turn.

-There will be no access into the building for the general public and no trying on or handling of merchandise at this time. Sales will be final.

-Debit and credit only- tap is available and the machine will be sanitized after every transaction.

The greenhouse is bursting with beautiful blooms, greenery and fragrances that help remind us of warmer days and simpler times. We are **now open** for the 2020 season and ask you to please note the following modified operational guidelines. These measures will remain in place for as long as necessary to help ensure community, customer and employee safety. With your support and cooperation, we're hoping we can remain open through these tough times to continue to provide you with everything you need to make summer a little brighter. Gardening and growing plants is a great way to cheer ourselves up as we continue to battle COVID-19.

New Rules:

- **Hours of operation: 7 days week - 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesdays, 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. is reserved for seniors and persons with disabilities or mobility issues who would like to shop at a quieter time.**
- We are limiting the number of shoppers in the greenhouses at any one time to ensure social distancing. If you forget to social distance, please know our staff will remind you.
- You're bound to run into folks you haven't seen for a while. The greenhouse is not the place for a catch-up - you can call or text them later. Please shop with purpose.
- Shopping carts and the Interac machine to be sanitized between shoppers.
- Please follow the "you-touch-it-you-buy-it" principle as best you can.
- The check-out area has been outfitted with plexiglass and special procedures for employee and customer safety.
- Please leave the kids at home – they love to run around the greenhouse (and frankly, who doesn't?) but it kills social distancing initiatives. If you must bring them, they are always to stay with you ; like one-hand-on-the-cart with you.
- The washrooms are closed to the public; please remember to go before you leave home.
- Payment method: debit or credit preferred.
- We are not taking back used plant pots for recycling at this time.
- Please stay away from the Flower Farm if you are:
 - Not feeling well or have any symptoms (sore throat, coughing, running nose, fever)
 - Have recently been exposed to anyone with COVID-19
 - Are in quarantine, as per Alberta Health Services
- Staff are on hand, as always to help you with your gardening questions – they just won't get as close to you as they used to.
